NRS 640.240 Requirements for educational curriculum.

- 1. For the purposes of <u>NRS 640.230</u>, the Board shall not approve any educational curriculum for a physical therapist's assistant unless the curriculum includes elementary or intermediate courses in clinical, anatomical, biological and physical sciences and is:
- (a) At least a 2-year program requiring a minimum of 60 academic semester credits at a college accredited by a recognized accrediting agency....
