MEETING MINUTES JANUARY 26, 2016

Item 1- Call to order / roll call to determine the presence of a quorum. After determining the presence of a quorum, the meeting was called to order at 8:01am. Committee members present: Joe Cracraft, PT, Chairman; JD Daruwalla, PT, Vice Chairman; Deborah Dieter, PT; Steve Bamberger, PT; Kirk Sachtler, PT. Non-members present: Allison Tresca, executive director.

Item 2- Public comment. There was no public comment.

Item 3- Review and approval of minutes of December 3, 2015.

Motion to approve: Daruwalla.

Passes unanimously.

Item 4- Update on request to the Board in updating the course review application instructions to include information on re-submission of previously approved courses and the requirement for current information for such submissions. The director reported that the Board approved their request to require 5 references that are no more than 5 years old, and the Board also approved their request to require a time calculation sheet for courses that are text based (books, articles, etc.).

Committee member Sachtler stated this seems to be creating more work for Board staff, as the Committee will need to develop guidelines as to what references are acceptable. He stated that denying references simply because of their age is not necessarily the right response, as it will depend on what the course content is. He stated he understands the Board and the Committee are trying to ensure the quality of the education. Member Cracraft noted that the idea of the timeframe and number of references came from the APTA. He noted the references are just to support the content of the course. Member Daruwalla noted that whatever references are provided, the Committee will determine whether or not they are valid and legitimate references, and do so on a course by course basis during the review process. It was discussed that perhaps the requirement for 5 references of no more than 5 years old, is not the best idea and the Committee will review at the next meeting as this agenda item was not noticed as an action item.
